I am a German and a literary man, and have now resided in this country for nearly 26 years. I have all this time supported myself by giving German lessons, by taking portraits, and by contributions to various foreign and English periodicals. I am sorry to say that lately through circumstances over which I had no control I have had but little to do and ~~that~~ I have been in somewhat feeble health, so that I have found myself in some severe difficulties, and have had to part with very many of my properties. I need I hope but little help to recover my losses, and to restore my peace of mind
